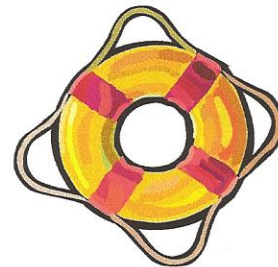

Sewer Installation

The Little Pond Sewer Service area main infrastructure installation is approximately half completed. We understand that while it will continue,

disruption and detour will be held to a minimum this Summer.

Sewer Policy

The Board of Selectmen recently approved a policy which addresses the Town's responsibility for the ongoing operation of the grinder pumps that will be installed by 700+ homeowners in the LPSSA. The policy includes town maintenance, repair and replacement of the pumps as required as well as town provided emergency power for the pumps during outages. In addition, there will be a one-time partial monetary reimbursement (amount to be determined) to help defray the cost of installing the pumps.
