VOTED: Article 27 passed on Tuesday, April 6, 1993, a majority vote, a quorum being present.

ART: 28 To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate a sum of money to be used by the Falmouth Chamber of Commerce to assist in the Off-Season Economic Improvement Program which would include the publication of brochures of Falmouth in a variety of languages to promote the Town's many areas of interest to domestic and international visitors. Or do or take any other action in this matter. On request of the Board of Selectmen.

AMENDED: To see if the Town will vote to raise and appropriate the sum of \$18,000 to be used by the Falmouth Chamber of Commerce to assist in the Off-Season Economic Improvement Program which would include the publication of brochures of Falmouth in a variety of languages to promote the Town's many areas of interest to domestic and international visitors. Provided that such sum would be matched by a like fund from the Chamber of Commerce.

VOTED: Article 28, as amended, passed on Tuesday, April 6, 1993, a majority vote, a quorum being present.

ART: 29 To see if the Town will vote to sanction the actions of the Board of Selectmen, acting as the Commissioners of Public Works, to grant minor extensions to the municipal sewer system if:

1. said extensions are constructed at no expense to the Town;
2. said extensions are constructed according to Town specifications, and may become the property of the Town within a Town accepted right of way or by granting an easement;
3. said extensions are for flows under two thousand (2000) gallons per day; and
4. said extensions are no longer than one thousand (1000) feet measured from the property line to the existing collector main,

or do or take any other action in this matter. On request of the Board of Selectmen.

VOTED: Article 29, as printed, passed on Tuesday, April 6, 1993, a majority vote, a quorum being present.

ART: 30 To see if the Town will vote to sell for One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) a parcel of land known as Parcel 12, Cloverfield Way, Falmouth, Assessors Map 6, Section 2, Parcel 12, Lot 000 which has been advertised and bids accepted as possible sale of surplus property. Or do or take any other action in this matter. On request of the Board of Selectmen.

VOTED: Article 30, as printed, passed on Tuesday, April 6, 1993 by a counted vote of 166 in favor and 11 opposed, the necessary 2/3 vote, a quorum being present.

ART: 31 To see if the Town will vote to accept the doings of the Selectmen in laying out a road fifty (50) feet wide, more or less, from existing Ter Heun Drive across land of Francis C. Lowell (Parcel I) and other now or formerly belonging to the Sippewissett Homeowners Association, Inc. (Parcel II). Or do or take any other action in this matter. On request of the Board of Selectmen.

VOTED: Article 31, as printed, passed on Wednesday, April 7, 1993 by a counted vote of 119 in favor and 62 opposed, a majority vote, a quorum being present.

ART: 32 To see if the Town will vote to take by eminent domain or purchase the following parcels of land, now or formerly belonging to Francis C. Lowell (Parcel I), the other now or formerly belonging to the Sippewissett Homeowners Association Inc. (Parcel II), for the purpose of constructing a portion of Ter Heun Drive to determine how the same shall be raised and by whom expended. Said land being described as follows:
