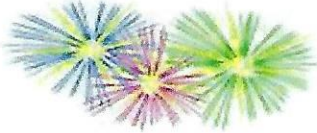

State tax credits for LPSSA Full Time Residents are available. Information was posted on the FHMNA website on 11/1/17. Please inform your tax professional once your connection is complete.

The Wastewater Superintendent has clarified that **garbage disposals** are not prohibited for sewer connections in Falmouth, whether gravity or low pressure or grinder pump. However, property owners should be aware that garbage disposals increase water use and can cause plumbing or sewer problems if not used properly. Sufficient water must be used when the garbage disposal is running to wash the ground food down the drain.

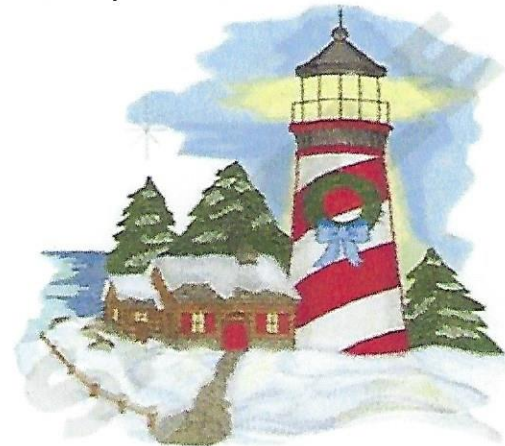
