New Balance Falmouth Road Race

August 18, 2019 marks the 47th running of the Falmouth Road Race (FRR) from Woods Hole to Falmouth Heights. Each year the 7 mile race draws an international field of Olympians. elite runners and recreational runners. Proceeds from the nonprofit race promote many Falmouth community groups. This vear. \$80,000 was awarded in scholarships and \$500,000 went to install a new track at Falmouth High School in conjunction with the multipurpose turf field.
